



## Henry Elwin Buck Sr.

Henry Elwin Buck, Sr. was born on February 11, 1934 and passed away May 24, 2019 at the age of 85, with his family by his side.

He was born in Rural Clark County Arkansas near the town of Arkadelphia, Arkansas where he grew up with his 6 brother and sisters on a farm. During his early years, he worked on his family's farm and spent much of his time hunting and fishing with his brothers. Arkansas was his favorite place on earth. He went into the Air Force in December of 1951 and was stationed at Youngstown, Ohio. On September 5, 1955, he was honorably discharged and returned to Arkadelphia, Arkansas. After he returned from the service, he moved to Houston, TX to work and lived with his sister, Margaret, and her family. In was in Houston, TX that he met the love of his life at Airline Drive Baptist Church. On September 4, 1959, he married Ruby Zane Rivers at Airline Drive Baptist Church in Houston, TX. After they married they resided in Houston and had their first child. They then returned to Arkadelphia, Arkansas for a short time while he attended college at Quachita Baptist University for religious studies. They would then return to Houston for him to go to Barber school. He started his career as a barber at Fogg's Barber Shop and would later open up Buck and Carroll Barber Shop in the Aldine area of North Houston where he worked for nearly 40 years.

The focus of his life was his family and faith in Jesus Christ. In the 1970's he and his family started attending Memorial Baptist Church in north Houston. He was a deacon and served in many leadership capacities within the church. He became the single's minister and this ministry would prove to be the most rewarding time in his service to our Lord. He touched many lives through his commitment to share the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ. He retired from barbering and moved to Willis, TX where he lived with his wife Ruby and enjoyed his family, his favorite past time which was God's nature, and his church, First Baptist of Willis.

Henry was preceded in death by his parents, Dock Estes Buck Sr. and Ruby Isabelle (Still) Buck; sisters, Julia (Dude) Francis and Margaret Key; brothers, Dock E. Buck, Jr., Thomas M. Buck, Donald E. Buck, and Ronald Neal Buck.

He is survived by his wife Ruby Zane (Rivers) Buck of 59 years; brother, E. W. Buck of Mt. Pleasant, TX; daughter Janet Fincher and husband Rusty Fincher; son Henry Buck Jr. and

wife Kim (Kroning) Buck; son, Warren Buck; grandchildren, Brian Fincher, John Fincher, Julia Fincher, Rebekah Buck, and Lauren Buck; and numerous nieces, nephews, and cousins.

Visitation with the family is scheduled for Thursday, May 30 from 6-8 PM at Sam Houston Memorial Funeral Home in Willis.
