



Marvin Gayland Moulder

August 25, 1931 - July 4, 2020

Gayland was born in Blum, Texas to Marvin T. & Nannie Mae (Isenberg) Moulder on August 25, 1931 and passed away at his home on July 4, 2020.

He was preceded in death by both parents and sister Emma Jean Rash. He is survived by his wife, Gerry, son Michael Moulder and wife Emma, daughter Shari Miller and husband Dean, four grandchildren and seven great grandchildren. He is also survived by his sister Barbara Nicklas and husband Derell and brother James Moulder and wife Lori as well as numerous other relatives and friends.

In his formative years Gayland and his family lived in many places and settled in Rio Vista, Texas where he graduated high school with a class of nine in 1949. He attended Arlington State College before joining the U S Navy during the height of the Korean War. He served aboard the Destroyer USS John R. Craig. He studied at the Torpedo School in Newport, R.I., and trained in Underwater Demolition at Key West, FL. Gayland was proud of his military service and accolades while serving.

While in the Navy Gayland met Gerry while on leave in Waco, Texas. After a two year long distance courtship they were married on July 8, 1954.

After discharge in 1955 Gayland & Gerry settled in Waco where he began his career at the U S Postal Service. Gayland graduated from Baylor University in 1962 with degrees in Accounting and Management. Gayland's career with the U S Postal Service included positions of Postal Inspector/Auditor in Atlanta, Georgia, Regional Manager in Dallas, Texas, District Manager in Waco, Texas and in 1972 he became Postmaster in Bryan, Texas and Area Manager for over 125 offices throughout East Texas. After his retirement he opened an accounting and property management business in Bryan/College Station. Gayland and Gerry moved to Elkins Lake in Huntsville, Texas in 1990. He became an avid golfer – not necessarily good, but frequent.

Since moving to Huntsville he has been pro-active at Elkins Lake. He was Interclub Captain for three years, President of the Interclub League, Elkins Lake Corporation Board Member serving as Secretary, Vice President and President, on the New Clubhouse Committee, Golf Committee and others. Gayland also served five years as a member of the City of Huntsville Board of Appeals. Gayland served for six years on the Board of Directors for the Wyndham Time Shares at Pagosa Springs, Co.

Gayland is a member of Elkins Lake Baptist Church in Huntsville.
