Thomas R. Doebbler, 83, of Huntsville, Texas passed away Saturday, 18 August 2018. He was born 22 November 1934 in San Antonio, Texas, the son of Frank J. and Vivian Rilling Doebbler.

He grew up in San Antonio and graduated from G.W. Brackenridge High School in 1951. He then attended the University of Texas before joining the US Coast Guard in 1957. While attending UT, he met Betty Hagaman and they were married on 31 August 1957.

Tom and Betty resided in Austin Texas, where their three children were born. In the summer of 1967, the family moved to Houston, ultimately settling in Deer Park, Texas.
