



A. L. "Trey" Davis III

November 26, 1989 - July 14, 2012

A.L. "Trey" Davis III was born November 26, 1989, in Conroe, Texas, to A. L. "Butch" Davis, Jr. and Sara White Davis. Trey, 22, went to be with his Lord and Savior on July 14, 2012 in Houston surrounded by family.

He was preceded in death by sister, Brandy Clark and grandfathers, A. L. Davis, Sr., and Leroy White. Those left to cherish his memory are his parents; grandparents, Mildred Davis and Jean White; sister Wendy Ingram and husband Mike; brothers JimBob Davis, Luke Clark and wife Anna, Justin Davis and wife Staci; Aunt Brenda and Uncle Charles Romans, Aunt Linda and Uncle Doug Ryland; along with numerous cousins, nieces, nephews and friends.

Trey, raised in Huntsville his entire life, attended Christian schools and graduated from Heritage Champion Academy in 2008. Trey was a member and rode with the Walker County 4H Horse club from a youngster until he was a young adult.

Trey had a tender heart and loving spirit. He poured his heart and soul into the sound and lighting of dramas and many other programs at Family Faith Church in Huntsville and Coldspring, Texas. Trey designed and built the sound and lighting system for the Family Faith Church at the Coldspring campus. He also had his own business "Forever in a Moment", in which he designed

sound and lighting systems and DJed numerous events.

Trey was honored by the City of Huntsville with a proclamation by the Mayor declaring February 19th as "Trey Davis day." Pastor Jeff Hackleman honored Trey as Volunteer of the year in 2006.

Trey touched many lives because of his outward attitude. He poured himself into the youth at the Family Faith Church and was instrumental in showing them the Glory of God through his words and actions and how he dealt with life. Trey began training with S.E.A.L.S. (Saints Evangelizing All Lost Souls) in the standards class at age 12, then trained and served as a youth leader at Family Faith Church. Trey was actively involved and served with the youth as well as the sounds and music ministry. In 2009 he received certification in Christian Ministry and Leadership of Biblical Studies.

During his last stay at Methodist Hospital in Houston, Trey remembered that he had not told his cat "Cheryl" good-bye. Trey loved cats. His passion for his cat, that went everywhere with him, softened his daddy's heart towards having cats around the house. Trey's daddy declares "Trey gave him 22 years of inspiration to his life. Trey never let his challenge with muscular dystrophy get him down." Bob French of Channel 3 in Bryan interviewed Trey several years while he was in high school, during the annual Muscular Dystrophy Telethon. Trey's faith in God is what helped him and his family through his journey with Muscular Dystrophy and continued to be his testimony. Trey never viewed himself as handicapped. Trey's mom reminds us that Trey never wanted sympathy from anyone and never wanted to be viewed as physically challenged. He wanted to be treated like everybody else. His mom made it her duty to make sure this happened as much as she could for her sweet son.
