She was born in the same house as her Father and Grandfather were before her. She had three brothers and one sister. She attended Creek High School and later Austonio High School. At age 17 on January 21, 1935 she married Austin Edward Sanders. Together they had three sons. Ada B. was saved at an early age and baptized in the local Methodist Church. After World War II she and her husband resided in Huntsville, Texas. They purchased a home and moved in January 26, 1946. She and her husband joined Calvary Baptist Church where she taught Sunday School and was the first RA Leader at the church. She was a loving and caring Mother, Wife and Grandmother. Her husband preceded her in death in 1997 at the age of 86. She lived for 87 years, 4 months and 5 days and on January 31, 2005 went to receive her rewards in Heaven promised to her by God himself. She is survived by three sons and their wives; George and Jennie Sanders of Montgomery, AL, Hershel and Catherine Sanders of Katy, Texas and Billy and Donna Sanders of Huntsville.
