



## Adrian Scott

April 11, 1918 - July 26, 2007

Adrian Thornton "Scottie" Scott, 89, of Huntsville died Sat., July 21, 2007 in Conroe, TX after a brief illness. Scottie was born April 11, 1918 in Somerville, TX to Judd Scott and Rosalie Sell Scott, the youngest of three children. He was proud to have served in the Civilian Conservation Corps at Grand Canyon, AZ and in the U.S. Army. After honorable discharge in 1946, he became a cross-country truck driver and finally settled down as a building contractor and painter in the Huntsville area. His talent touched many fine homes, churches, government buildings, and schools in southeast TX. Scottie was a generous, loving, honorable man whose word was his bond; his handshake, his contract. Scottie is preceded in death by Daisy, his wife of 54 years; brother Robert; and sister Grace.
