Ainsley Fiona Stovall was born on December 29, 1969 to Wilburn and Janet Stovall and went home to be with her Lord and Savior on September 10, 2020. Ainsley was born with Down's Syndrome, a serious heart defect and an exuberant personality. When she was five and weighed thirty pounds very successful open-heart surgery corrected the heart defects. Growing up she developed very good verbal, reading, writing and age appropriate interpersonal skills. The most important gift she was given was her wonderful personality which made her a friend of everyone, bubbling with enthusiasm, laughter and full of concern for people who were handicapped. She always said "I'm so glad that I'm not handicapped". She was a real "people person". In Scotland I had worked with children in special education so when she was born, I asked God to give her the ability to read so that she could read her Bible. My request was granted. She knew and loved Jesus and became a real witness for Him. She had no qualms about asking a person "do you know Jesus?" and talking with them about Him. Ainsley loved to work and help people. She has an excellent work record. She was employed by Fuddruckers, then Taco Bell for some ten years in food service. then by the Sheraton Hotel in housekeeping. Later by Acey Janitorial Service for a number of years. The events of 9/11/01 ended her time at the Sheraton and the onset of Alzheimer's ended her time with Acey. Aside from work she enjoyed several activities: competing in swimming and bowling in the Special Olympics: "going out to dinner" anywhere from McDonalds to the finest of

restaurants; and going on vacation with us locally or to Scotland or Hawaii or New York. Anywhere on a plane was her favorite. Ainsley enjoyed her full, well rounded life to the fullest. Many people's lives were touched and blessed by her. Ainsley is survived by her loving parents, Wilburn and Janet Stovall, her brother Robert Stovall, sister and brother in law, Lorna and John Durschinger and nephew August Durschinger. A funeral service took place in El Cajon, California and a graveside service will be held on Saturday, September 19, 2020 at Pool's Cemetery in Richards, TX at 1:00pm.
