Services for Allen Keith Lawrence, 46 of Huntsville, Texas will be held at Sam Houston Memorial Funeral Home in Huntsville at 11:00am Monday, February 3, 2014, with Pastor Darrell Clenney officiating. Visitation will be prior to the service and will begin at 10:00am. Keith was born on January 20, 1968 in Huntsville and lived there all his life. He graduated from Huntsville High School in 1986. He worked at TDCJ as a security guard, and for the Trust Fund Dept., and at UTMB as an EMT and dispatcher. He died at Conroe Regional in the early morning hours of January 30, 2014 after a long battle with illnesses and cancer. Keith loved the outdoors and loved living and raising his son Cody by himself at his grandfather's estate home, where he spent many happy years as a child himself. He had a heart of gold and had a strong belief in his Christian faith and read the Bible to Cody almost every night before bedtime. From the minute his son was born, Keith said that Cody was his heart and he never wavered in his effort to raise Cody in faith, and to be a loving and caring person to all. Keith was preceded in death by his grandparents, Allen and Billie Baldwin, and his brother, Dean Lawrence. He is survived by his son Cody Lawrence, mother Ann Brown and husband Joe, of Palestine, Texas, sister Debra Robinson and husband Walter of Edgewood, Washington, Uncles Bob Baldwin of Bryan ,Texas and Jim Baldwin and wife, Gina Baldwin of Georgetown, Texas and parents Wayne and Eve Lawrence of Huntsville, Texas.
