



Alma Lucille Marks

March 3, 1913 - October 14, 2006

Alma Lucille Kees Marks was born March 3, 1913 in Buckeye, Louisiana to Mary Evelyn and Benjamin Franklin Kees. She died October 10, 2006. Lucille was preceded in death by her husband, Frank Arnold Marks, Jr.; by her parents; by brothers Elon Kees, Bert Kees, and Jesse Kees; and by sisters Pearl Dyer and Joyce Dunn. She is survived by her son, Bobby Kees Marks and his wife, Colleen; by granddaughters Denice Leanne Crosby and Donna Deanne Laverell; by her great grandson James Aaron Hall and great granddaughter Kimberly Ann Hall; by a brother James L. Kees, and by many nieces and nephews. Lucille grew up in Louisiana, in the small rural communities of Buckeye and LaCompte, near Alexandria, where her father served on the school board and was a retail merchant and farmer, raising cotton and sugar cane. Most of Lucille's adult years were spent in Beaumont where she lived until the death of her husband in 1977. For many years, Lucille taught a Sunday School class of second graders. A few months following her husband's death, Lucille moved to Huntsville, where she has resided since the spring of 1978. Following her move to Huntsville, Lucille was active in many local organizations, including the Newcomers Club, Hospital Auxiliary, Garden Club, and Elkins Lake Baptist Church. A funeral service for Lucille is scheduled for Saturday, October 14, at 10 am in the chapel of Sam Houston Memorial Funeral Home, with burial at 3 pm at Forest Lawn Memorial Park at 4955 Pine Street - in Beaumont, Texas.
