Andrew Jack Johnson was born July 3, 1920 in Stephens Creek, Texas to Johnny Henry and Fannie Mae (Gesling) Johnson. He was the only boy in the family with six sisters. He passed away October 9, 2006 in Conroe, Texas. He was very patriotic so after the bombing of Pearl Harbor he hitchhiked to San Antonio to join the US Army. He was wounded while serving in the Philippines and spent many months in the hospital recovering. He and Thelma were married while he was in the hospital. They moved to Houston where their four children were born. Later in life he married Miriam who had two children. When they retired they returned to Stephens Creek and built a home on his family's home place. Mr. Johnson is survived by daughter Penny Crist, of Coldspring, son Ronald Johnson and wife Linda of Lake Whitney, daughter Linda Bodiford and husband Barney of Henderson, Nevada, daughter Sharon Mueller and husband Terry of Henderson, Nevada, step-son Michael Murphy and wife Sue of Kerrville, and ten grandchildren; Virginia, Ricky, Anna, Ronald Jr., Amelia, Tracy, Melody, Casissa, Mandy and Paul David Carby and numerous other family members and friends.
