She is survived by her children Kelsey Marie and Colt Morgan, along with Fiancée Kyle Devillier and his family. Ann loved to travel, hunt, fish, and she was happiest when she was spending time with friends and family. Her greatest gift was being called mom and there was no greater joy to her than her two children whom she would have sacrificed everything for. Ann was a lifetime member of the Walker County Fair Association where she served as a vice president and volunteer for many years. She served on the USDA Farm Service Agency Board for Walker County, the Walker County Ag Appraisal Board, she was an adult leader in the Walker County 4-H, secretary of the Buck Foster Cemetery Board, and assisted with numerous other community service organizations. She was a remarkable woman, always smiling and selfless to the very end. Together we lived life to the

fullest. She taught us to be caring, strong, and independent young adults. She was so very proud of us, but we are more proud to call her Momma!
