Ann Louise Shafer, born October 9, 1934, passed away at her home on Monday, September 4, 2006. She was married to Joe Shafer on July 17, 1953. In addition to being a loving, devoted wife of 53 years, she was a dedicated mother to their son, Ken, who preceded her in death in 1995.
