“ Uncle Grumpy (my name for him) didn’t survive the sudden heart attack but he went like the fighter that he was. He was one of my mentors, and he taught me fearlessness at an early age (turning somersaults in his little two-seater plane while he let me steer...and I heard this week that he landed his plane on Hwy 75 in an emergency once). He loved motorcycles, too, and he rode from New Waverly, Texas, as far north as the Dakotas, usually with Aunt Margaret in a sidecar (even after he had triple bypass heart surgery and was well into his 70’s). He played the guitar and sang, could fix anything mechanical (and if the tiniest valve was faulty, he’d just make a new one because it had to be perfect). Five years ago he gave up his adventures to take care of his beloved wife who suffered from alzheimers. They celebrated their 60th wedding anniversary last month. Uncle Grumpy died on Mother’s Day at the very young age of 82, and he left very clear orders: no funeral, no service of any kind. He didn’t want to “cause any trouble.” It’s okay, for we shared lots of stories this week with family and friends, and we think he was listening.
