



Barbara Jo Strouts

June 16, 1944 - July 17, 2025

Barbara Jo Strouts, beloved wife, mother, grandmother, and great-grandmother, passed away on the evening of July 17, 2025, at Methodist Woodlands Hospital in Houston, Texas, just one week after a sudden cancer diagnosis. She was 81 years old. Her daughter Jeannie was by her side. Born on June 16, 1944, in Cincinnati, Ohio, Barbara was the daughter of William and Frances Hendricks. She built a life rooted in family, faith, and service.

After raising her three daughters with her husband Jack, Barbara returned to school later in life and graduated as valedictorian of her nursing class. She went on to become a nurse practitioner specializing in women's health, where her intelligence, empathy, and professionalism earned the trust of many.

Barbara was an avid reader and a lifelong nature lover. She and her husband Jack shared a passion for exploring remote natural wonders, often seeking out quiet places to hike and stay in charming bed-and-breakfasts or inns.

She is survived by her husband of 60 years, Jack Strouts; daughters Carol, Annie, and Jeannie; seven grandchildren; and three great-grandchildren. She is also survived by her sisters Marty, Jan, and Fran.

Barbara will be remembered for her grace, her quiet strength, and—as Jack often said—for being the sweetest person in the room.
