Beatrice was affectionately known to everyone as "Mema" or "Bea". Family was important to her and her home was the heart of the family where everyone loved to be, especially for the holidays. She was a caregiver for her invalid son, husband and mother. She also raised five children and helped raise eleven grandchildren and seven great-grandchildren. Beatrice was a pioneer woman. Her grandparents emigrated from Poland to New Waverly to work as sharecroppers. She learned at an early age the meaning of hard work and continued that strong work ethic throughout her life. She and her husband, Raymond opened Huntsville Feed and Farm in 1956. It prospered as a family business for 51 years. She also enjoyed gardening, raising animals and managing properties.
