Bertha Lee Boswell went to be with her Lord and Savior on July 18, 2015. Her friends and family called her “Micky” while her grandchildren and great grandchildren called her Mamaw Micky. As children they would sing “Mamaw Micky, Mickey Mouse” to her for fun. She loved to play with little children and they enjoyed time with her. She lost her husband Garland Brinson “Red” Boswell in 1969. Her parents Ed and Minnie Florence Jefferson preceded her in death along with her younger brothers Ed Wesley and twins Emery and Avery Jefferson. Her longevity of 98 years surpassed her Grandfather John Greer’s record of 95 years.
