Betty Pearl Ready Vickery was born on December 19, 1931, in Coldspring, TX to her parents, Eulas Franklin Ready and Mary Lela McCants Ready. She went to be with the Lord on June 2, 2023 in New Waverly, Texas at the age of 91.

She attended school in Coldspring as a child but her family moved to Port Arthur, TX where she graduated High School in 1949 from Thomas Jefferson High School. She returned to college after her children entered school and completed her Bachelor's Degree in Education in 1970 from Lamar University in Beaumont, TX. She began her teaching career in Sabine Pass, Texas from 1970 to 1978. She then returned to Coldspring, Texas, where she taught elementary school from 1978 to 1990 with the exception of one year, 1989, where she taught in Shepherd, Texas. She retired in 1990 to enjoy caring for her beloved granddaughter.

Betty accepted Jesus Christ as her savior on April 12, 1953 where she attended Beacon Baptist Church in Wichita Falls, TX. She taught Sunday School and studied the Bible the remainder of her life as long as she was able. At the time of her passing, she was a member of the Pine Valley Baptist Church in New Waverly, Texas.

Betty was married to Lonnie Elwood Vickery on March 25, 1951, celebrating

72 years of marriage this year. She has one daughter, Ramona Christopher and her husband, Jay, granddaughter, Anna Marie Pierce, and nephew, Dennis Ready all of Coldspring, TX. She loved her family and avidly researched the genealogy of all her ancestors. She also enjoyed her husband's large family which includes numerous nieces and nephews.
