September 15, 1939 - October 1, 2015

Billy Edward Kennedy died October 1, 2015, in the Conroe Regional Medical Center's Critical Care Unit at the age of 76. Born in Lufkin, Texas, to Lois and William Kennedy, Bill began his education in the Lufkin ISD and graduated magna cum laude from Lufkin High School. He was quickly recruited by the University of Texas Baseball Team, starting as a varsity player and soon having an opportunity to join the Pittsburg Pirates Organization. Unfortunately, a shoulder injury prevented him from following that career. Bill proudly served in the U.S. Army during the Vietnam War receiving a Medal of Valor.

Upon returning home, he became an avid freshwater fisherman--winning contests across Texas. He joined Carpenter Steel Technology as an Inside Sales Specialist.

On January 17, 1976, Bill married Nancy Lee Davis and adopted her son David. For years he continued to enjoy fishing, hunting, golfing, attending the Huntsville Church of Christ, and raising his beloved cat Waylon.

Survivors include his wife Nancy, his son David, his grandson Davis, and his mother-in-law Dorothy Alexander Davis.
