Bobby Gene Conner was born in Houston, Texas June 11, 1934 and passed away June 3, 2007 in Temple Texas. He grew up in northeast Houston and went to Galena Park High School, where he played football and married his high school sweetheart in October 1953. He attended the University of Houston and was a Sergeant in the Army National Guard Reserve. Mr. Conner had three children whom he loved dearly. The young family started their lives together in Jacinto City, and moved to Pasadena in the summer of 1959. In 1975, they moved to Kingwood/Porter area. He was later transferred to Louisiana then Birmingham, Alabama while working for Rust Engineering as an engineer. They lived in Burlington, Texas at the time of his death. Bobby was also a member of the Masonic Lodge #1155 A.F & A.M. in Pasadena, Texas and the Luke Methodist Church in Houston.
