



## Bobby Gene Seals

October 10, 1936 - July 13, 2018

On Friday, July 13, 2018, Bobby Gene Seals, 81, beloved husband, father, grandfather and brother passed away peacefully at his home in Conroe, TX to be with his Lord and Savior surrounded by his loving family.

Bobby was born in Bevins, TX on October 10, 1936 to J.W “Buck” and Cecil Wilson Seals. He graduated from Magnolia High School on May 23, 1955 where he excelled in track and field, basketball and football. He attended the University of Houston after being awarded a football scholarship to play Quarterback.

Bobby worked as Vice President of Operations for Wilson Industries for 39 years. He began his career in the Oil and Gas industry in his early twenties as a roughneck, working his way up through the ranks with his relentless work ethic, determination and love for his family. He eventually became the youngest employee to earn the title of Vice President in Wilson history at the age of 32. He retired in 1998 to his beloved lakefront home in Seven Coves on Lake Conroe. In retirement, Bobby would rise with the sun every morning to enjoy his coffee outside and watch the sunrise. He took a lot of pride in working on his beautifully manicured yard and garden as well as restoring his 1931 Ford Model A. Bobby was very involved with his children’s sport activities, often coaching his sons’ and daughter’s football, baseball and softball teams to much success. Bobby was an avid outdoorsman, spending

time enjoying the company and comradery of family and friends at his deer lease. He also enjoyed raising and caring for over forty goats at his goat farm in Willis with his best friend Barney Barnhart.

Bobby married his high school sweetheart and wife of 60 years, Connie Joe Haynes, on June 21, 1958. Together they loved, nurtured and raised three children, two sons and one daughter. Bobby Gene Seals Jr. and wife Sherri Seals of Willis, TX, Lisa Jo Seals Adair and husband Zeke Adair of Sugar Land, TX and Brett Tyson Seals and wife Ashley Seals of Conroe, TX.

Bobby was preceded in death by his father, J.W "Buck", his mother Cecil, son Matthew Bryan, sister Jo Ann Harrison and brothers J.W "Bubba" Seals and Russell Seals. 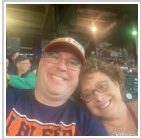
