



## Boyce Dean Stalter Sr.

December 18, 1944 - December 19, 2020

Boyce Dean Stalter Sr was born in Athens, Texas on December 18, 1944 and died at Memorial Herman Hospital in the Woodlands from a complication of a knee infection from a total knee replacement done on October 26th, 2020.
