Bruce William Baker passed at the age of 58 on March 4th 2020. Born in New York City, Bruce eventually enlisted in the Marine Corps as an infantryman that was deployed to Beirut, Lebanon during the barracks bombing incident. Following an Honorable Discharge, Bruce traveled the eastern and southern states in pursuit of work and family before settling in the north Houston area as a single parent with two sons. For most of Bruce's life he was an automotive and diesel mechanic, however NOV gave him a great opportunity to finally work indoors with clean hands as a machinist for close to a decade. It was during this time he found his wife Dianna and his final resting place in Huntsville, Texas. He enjoyed working with his hands and helping anyone that would ask, being outside hiking and observing nature, and watching the races or anything with an engine.
