Buford Deryl Kile , of Huntsville, Texas went home to be with his Lord on June 1, 2013. Deryl was born in Kisatchie, Louisiana on January 16, 1925. Those left to cherish his memories are his wife of 62 years Bobbie Polke Kile; daughter Hollie Owens of Mooringsport, Louisiana; daughter Anita Jones and son-in-law Donnie Jones of Huntsville, Texas; daughter Rennie Smith and son-in-law Mike Smith of Bossier City, Louisiana.; and grandsons Jeremy Owens, Ron Campbell, Roman Campbell, Josh Jones and Andy Jones. Mr. Kile is preceded in death by his parents John and Allie Key Kile and brothers and sisters Linnie, Grady, Floyd, Irene, Verdie, Essie, Elmo and Lavelle . After graduating from Kisatchie High School in 1942, Deryl joined the United States Army where he served in the Pacific at Okinawa, Japan during WWII. In 1945 he was wounded by enemy gunfire in the Ryukyus Campaign. After receiving a purple heart and an honorable discharged, Deryl went to work for the United States Forest Service on the Kisatchie National Forest District in Louisiana and retired with 36 years. He enjoyed talking about his Lord, serving in his church, fishing, hunting, vegetable gardening, traveling America and LSU football. Before moving to Huntsville in 2001, Deryl and his wife Bobbie lived in Bellwood, La since 1951. Services for Mr. Kile will be held at Sam Houston Memorial Funeral Home in Huntsville on Sunday, June 2nd at 3 pm with Reverend Tommie Haley officiating. Visitation with family will be held one hour prior to service time at 2 pm. Burial will be at the Kisatchie Cementary at Kisatchie, Louisiana.
