



Calum Lee Wolfe

August 20, 1979 - October 6, 2024

Calum Lee Wolfe was born August 20 , 1979 in Gonzales, TX to Ron and Judy Wolfe. He attended Katy High School. He joined the United States Army and served in Hawaii. He married Samantha Howell and they had a daughter Jolee Wolfe. He learned his trade as an X-ray technician in the Army. When he was discharged he returned to Katy, then moved to The Woodlands. He met and married Christy Wolfe and they had a son Calum Jr. He served the people of Montgomery and The Woodlands as an X-ray technician, then as a CT and MRI technician. His battle with alcoholism and depression led to severe liver disease which became disabling to him, and took him to the brink of liver transplant. He received treatment at the VA Hospital, and was able to recover for a time, before relapsing and becoming critically ill. He turned 45 years old in critical care, before eventually succumbing to the complications of multiple infections. He died peacefully in the company of friends and family in Hospice care on October 6th, 2024. He was preceded in death by his mother, Judy Wolfe. He is survived by his father Ron, his brother Roger, and his children Jolee and Calum junior, as well as countless friends.

Calum will be remembered as a father who dedicated his life to raising his children to the best of his ability. He was an avid Houston Astros baseball fan and Dallas Cowboys football fan. He loves to grill and spend time with his friends. He was a large personality who commanded the room, and a gentle soul. He is at home with his mother and awaits all of us to join him at that big party in the sky, where the Astros always win the World Series, and the Super

Bowl trophy lives permanently in Dallas, TX.
