After closing Flow Quip he worked at several Engineering firms through out the Houston/Gulf Coast area. He later joined the construction partnership of SER Construction Partners, LLC and retired from there in 2012.

He and Karla have enjoyed meeting and making many new and wonderful friends since moving to the beautiful community of Walden on Lake Conroe. Carl was very active in Walden serving for 12 years on the WCIA Board, after leaving the Board he continued serving his community as a member of the Finance Committee. He was still serving on that committee along with being a member of the Board of Section 5 up until his death. He was a member of the Walden Follies where his talents were best utilized in the operation of one of the spot lights and serving on it's board for three years as their Treasurer. The community honored him in 2011 for his contributions by naming him Walden's Citizen of the Year.

He enjoyed traveling, sportfishing, playing poker, gin and cooking for and dining out with his wife, family and friends. His biggest joy, however, was spending time with his family. Sunday dinners sitting around the kitchen table where the family enjoyed, and will forever remember, his wickedly good sense of humor and his unique story telling style.
