Carole A. Tiefenbach nee Boulay, beloved wife to Timothy, devoted mother to Katherine, Kandice, Kimberly and Cassidy, died peacefully at home, at age 47, on Saturday, April 29, 2017, after a tenacious battle with brain cancer in Montgomery, Texas.
