Thanksgiving '25 followed that tradition ensuring she had room for pumpkin pie with extra whipped cream. The family moved to the Huntsville area eventually where her dad worked for Gulf States & her mom had a beautician shop. Carolyn enjoyed hanging out at Josey Boy Scout Lodge with her dad since he was a Scout Master. She also spent a lot of time at the Josey ball field playing softball & was a formidable catcher according to stories.

Carolyn graduated from New Waverly High School & soon after married. They moved to Huntsville where they had two daughters. She worked as a dispatcher for Huntsville Police Department among a few other jobs. Her parents eventually "retired" and opened Jo's Donuts & Bob's Locksmith just off the square in Huntsville. Carolyn was known for her amazing cookies and cakes & made some crazy big wedding cakes. She often bribed the girls

school bus driver with a cookie or pastry and a cold bottle of Coke to drop them off at the donut shop instead of home.

Carolyn later moved to the Oyster Creek area where she worked for Brazoria Co Sheriff's Dept and Oyster Creek Marshal's Dept as a dispatcher.

Eventually she relocated to the Chandler/Tyler area with her mom. Her love for law enforcement continued to grow. While working for area Sheriff Depts as a dispatcher, she completed the Law Enforcement Academy & became a fulltime Deputy. After several years, she became the Chief of Security at Emerald Bay Country Club, among other positions there. She fell in love & genuinely cared for the residents, which led to her house and pet sitting for these friends. She loved spending time with the animals!

She later relocated back to the Grangerland & New Waverly areas where she worked for Texas Depart of Corrections until her illness struck in February '25. She eventually retired at the end of April. She was also a member of the Caney Creek Cowboy Church in Conroe.

She was a wonderful and beautiful woman, mother, G-Maw, sister and friend. When she put her mind to doing something, she did it! She loved everyone with all of her heart which is evidenced by her lifelong friendship with her best friend/sister Vicki Hairgrove since they were 6 years old.
