August 18, 1919 - July 21, 2006

Born 08/18/1919 during the influenza pandemic in San Angelo Texas to Edgel Ovenia and Newton Monroe Jones. She entered into rest on Saturday, July 15, surrounded by her family, at her beloved Spring Branch Memorial Medical Center where, in the late 60s and early 70s she was instrumental in recruiting the cardiovascular and neurovascular surgeons who helped make this a major medical center.
