It was surprising at first as I'd not seen him in quite a few years, and in much less domestic roles, but it was so exciting to see him again and meet his little Carson, Shane & Shaylynn, and see that he looked to be pretty good at what he was doing (regardless of the dirty little faces daddies sometimes seem to miss).

This past August I watched Shelby's Carson, then 4, and Christy & Shannon's two youngest kids (Shaylynn & Shane) when I had a pool party for my little cousin Ethan. Christy called practically every hour to make sure they were okay, eating, not running around the pool, behaving, and so on... sweetly protective, subtly doting but always making sure they were minding and well behaved. It's so very hard to believe that Carson, the same little fella who was running around my pool double fisting popsicles just six months ago, is gone, and that makes me cry.

The fact those kids ran me ragged that day makes me thankful for those hours I spent trying to understand what Carson was saying and thankful for sweet Shay (or "Shay Shay" as she preferred to be called) or Shane to interpret when I just couldn't quite get what Carson wanted or needed. The day was a bit difficult insisting Carson eat a hot dog when all he wanted was Cheetos and popsicles but we finally did it (with Christy's coaxing and insistence that I be firm). Listening to him babble on to me, my mom, dad, cousin David, sister Jimi and the rest of my family, like he'd known us forever made us all fall in love that day. He trusted me enough to jump to me from the side of the pool without his floaties when I told him it'd be okay and that I would catch him, but as soon as he landed in my arms he proceeded to tell me, in a very serious voice, the importance of floaties and how he must always wear them. The energy I spent trying to catch that boy that day and finally forcing him to stop so I could put sunblock on him was a chore in itself but he finally obliged after a threat to make him sit out of the fun - as

much as I didn't want to. The funniest moment of the day was watching him do the goofy dance with Shay, Shane, Samantha & Andee on the water wall (I'm pretty sure Shannon taught them those crazy space cadet moves! lol).
