Charlene Gorman, 93, went home to her loving Heavenly Father the morning of Monday, August 6, 2018 in Arlington, TX.

Frankie Lois Charlene Gorman was born March 24, 1925 in Huntsville, TX to Frank Pegoda and Lula Mae Burnett Pegoda. She was the 11th of 12 children and grew up on the family farm in Huntsville. During World War II, while working in Corpus Christi, Charlene met her future husband, Edward Joseph Gorman. Their 52 year marriage began on April 5, 1943 in Fort Worth, TX. In 1955 the family moved to Arlington where she retired in 1990 from the Arlington Independent School District as a cafeteria manager.
