Charles William Bolding, 80, of West Sandy went home to be with his Lord, Tuesday, March 7, 2017. He was born in Houston, Texas to Claude Hunter and Beulah Emma McAfee Bolding on September 11, 1936.

In the late 70's to the mid 80's he and Jeanette traveled to Florida, Mississippi, Tennessee and various Texas towns building golf courses. His final job before retirement was at Louisiana-Pacific in New

Waverly, TX.

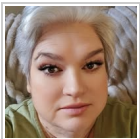
