Charles Edward Calcote Charles Edward Calcote was born September 10, 1939, Lincoln County, Mississippi. He died April 18, 2012 in New Waverly, Texas. He was married to Jan Calcote of New Waverly for 53 Years. Other survivors are, son, Tim Calcote of Huntsville, Texas; daughter Lisa Hayman of New Waverly, Texas; two granddaughters Makenzie and Madison Hayman of New Waverly, Texas; three siblings, and numerous friends and relatives. Charles was a Past Master of Conroe Masonic Lodge # 748 A.F. & A.M. He was also a former District Deputy Grand Master of the Grand Lodge of Texas. Charles was a 32° member of the Scottish Rite. He was in the National Guard and the Army Reserve. His first job was at the age of 13 at the Chevrolet dealership in Gulfport, Mississippi. After that he took a job with Sears as a Salesman. After getting married, he went to work for Cannon Shoes. This job led them from Galveston, Texas to Pensacola, Florida, to Big Spring, Texas, and ending in Conroe, Texas. Here he went to work doing Ironwork and was proud to have worked on downtown Houston Skyscrapers, NASA, and the Astrodome. He then took a job at the Dodge dealership in Conroe, Texas. In 1971 he purchased M&M Café in New Waverly, Texas. He owned this establishment until December 15, 2010. During the ownership of "The Café" he also owned Rogers Produce in Conroe, Texas, Burger Place in Cleveland, Texas and a car dealership in Huntsville.
