Charles Everett, age 76, of Walden, died October 5 in Conroe following an extended illness. Born December 22, 1930 to Clete Elkins Everett and Gladys Upshaw in Lillie, Louisiana, his family moved to Port Arthur, where he graduated from Thomas Jefferson High School. Charles served in the Army Reserve, and the Army of the United States, receiving an honorable discharge.
