CHARLES EDWARD GRANT JR. 81, of Montgomery (April Sound), TX died on Saturday, March 11th, 2017. "Charlie" Grant, son of Charles and Esther Grant, was born on October 5th, 1935 in Buffalo, New York. He was the middle of three children. Charlie was the loving husband of Elliene Ruby (Pokrant) Grant, who preceded him in death in November of 2011.

Charlie died after a long series of illnesses.

His older sister, Faye, preceded him in death.
