



## Charles Monday

January 16, 1913 - December 12, 2008

Charles Woodrow Monday, (Charlie to his friends and Poppee to his grandchildren) died peacefully in his sleep on December 8th, 2008 at the age of 95. Charlie was born on January 16, 1913 to John William and Edna Mae Monday in Amarillo, Texas. After high school in Vivian, he attended Northwestern State University in Louisiana, graduating with a B.S. in Biology and Chemistry. As a college senior he met his beloved “Darlin” Dorothy Bryan and they married on March 22, 1936. Following graduation he went to work as a chemist for Standard of Indiana and worked as engineer, and plant manager before retirement from B.P. Amoco in 1978. Charlie and his family lived in Vivian, Louisiana, Beeville and Bishop Texas during his career, and he and Dorothy settled in Corpus Christi Texas in 1979 following retirement. In 2000 Poppee and Dee moved to Huntsville to be closer to family. Charlie was a true “modern man”, as comfortable in his garden or kitchen as he was in his successful career. He was a scoutmaster, Chairman of the Board in the Methodist Church, refereed Little League, built their home in Beeville, a lake house and enlarged their Bishop home. Following retirement he became an avid golfer, educated himself as a genealogist, and completed over 100 works of needlepoint art. He and his wife felt strongly about education, and endowed a scholarship at their Alma matter Northwestern State University. Most importantly, Poppee lived as an example to his family. He was a loving and committed husband of 72 years, a supportive father, and ever present in his role as a cheerleader for his grandchildren and great-grandchildren. He is

survived by his beloved wife Dorothy Bryan Monday, son Charles Woodrow Monday Jr. and daughter in law Jane Clements Monday of Huntsville, daughter Dorothy Jean Monday Shockley and son in law Thomas V. Shockley of Georgetown, sister Betty Lou Monday King of Vivian Louisiana, nieces Renea King Tolbert of Louisiana, Debi King Daigle of Beaumont, Edna Ann Clark of Plain Dealing Louisiana, and nephew J.W. Monday of Dayton Texas. Poppee is also survived by his grandchildren Kimberly Elizabeth Monday and partner Lauren Marangell of Houston, Julie Monday Ballard and husband Buddie Cloys Ballard of Austin, Bryan Browning Shockley and wife Kathy Shockley of Dallas, Carey Shockley Deanda of Dallas, and Jennifer Monday Goldman and husband Adam Goldman also of Austin.
