Christopher Parrish Barrow, 25, passed away unexpectedly Monday, March 21, 2016 in a car accident. He was born to Chrissy Mafrige-Cogdell and Craig Barrow in Huntsville, Texas on September 23, 1990.

He was his family's strong and steady, their spiritual compass, and their loyal leader. He spoke often of the kind of father and husband he wanted to be – loving, affectionate, faithful and habitually present – the type of father and future husband he had already become. His smile was genuine and infectious, and always accompanied a breathtaking hug.

Accepting Christ into his life at an early age, Christopher constantly did his best to exhibit the qualities of a God-fearing and God-loving man. His family watched him grow into the responsible man of God his mother always knew he was destined to become.
