Clarence E. Ham, P.E., Lt. Colonel (USAF retired) Clarence E. Ham, born December 5, 1922 to Edgar and Lillian Ham, went to be with his Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ on October 31, 2010, at the Air Force Village I in San Antonio, Texas. Clarence grew up in Huntsville, Texas and was a charter member of the Calvary Baptist Church. He enlisted in the Army Air Corp in 1942 and was commissioned as an officer. He served in the European Campaign and completed 44 missions as a Navigator /Bombardier over Germany during WWII. After WWII he continued to serve in the reserves and was recalled to active service in the U.S. Air Force in 1952. He served in a number of duty stations and then was then provided the opportunity by USAF to obtain a degree in Civil Engineering from Oklahoma A&M (State) which he completed with high honors and was inducted into Phi Kappa Phi in 1956. His Air Force career continued with duty stations to Taiwan, Philippines, Alaska and Okinawa. He also had state side duties with the Strategic Air Command at Offutt AFB (SAC HQ) and Barksdale AFB (2nd AF HQ). He retired from the U.S. Air Force in 1969 with multiple awards and commendations. He was preceded in death by his parents, his wife of 50 years, Hermie Ham and wife of 12 years Juanita Ham, four sisters, Lucille Mann, Louise Sandel, Juanita Winslett and Joy Montgomery.
