Jr's walk with Christ left footprints no one could fill. He was a Godly man not just on Sundays but lived his faith wherever he was. Whether at his job, home, deer lease, church, etc. he wanted to make an impact, not just an impression: for everyone to experience the abundant life, found only in Jesus Christ, as stated in John 10:10-"Satan comes to steal, kill, and destroy. But I, Jesus Christ, have come to give life and give it more abundantly." He was an avid hunter, outdoorsman, outdoors and sports photographer, man of integrity, exceptional husband and father, and according to his daughter Samantha, "gave the very best hugs, thought he was always right, had to have the last word always, needed to explain everything and I mean everything, and is the best father God ever molded in his image!" He was very active in Northside Baptist Church. He was chairman of deacons, Sunday School teacher, ROTC (Reaching Outside the Church) leader, and Media/Sound technician. In the words of Pastor Reagan Cooksey, "He was my right hand man". He was a TDCJ ID employee of 25+ years, most recently as an EEO investigator. He is survived by his wife of 25 years Brenda Bennett Glass of Dodge and daughter Samantha of Dodge. He is also survived by his mother Lula Mae of Huntsville, sister Mary Sue of Canal Fulton, OH; brothers and their families Grady of Huntsville, John Earl of Rosenberg, Thomas of Point Blank, and Zachery of Riverside. He is further survived by his in-laws Billy Joe and Evelyn Bennett, brother-in-law and his family Billy of Huntsville and sister-in-law and her family Karen Jones of Canal Fulton, OH. Services will be held Wednesday April 18,

2007 at the Northside Baptist Church at 2 PM with Rev. Reagan Cooksey officiating. Interment will follow at Dodge Cemetery under the direction of Sam Houston Memorial Funeral Home.
