



Clement Marshall

December 26, 1933 - March 27, 2008

Clement Edwin Marshall, 74, of New Waverly lost his battle with colon cancer and went to be with the Lord on Sunday, March 23, 2008. He was born in Brenham, Texas on December 26, 1933. He was preceded in death by his father Ignatz Joseph Marshall and his father and mother-in-law Stanley and Lena Nowak. Clem is survived by his mother, Hedwig Virgie Kaminski Marshall, his wife of 55 years, Mary, daughter Pat Slott and her husband Danny "Sug", daughter Debbie Halter, son Donald Marshall and his wife Linda, brothers Daniel and Joe Marshall, numerous grandchildren, great grand children, aunts, uncles, nieces, nephews, cousins, other relatives and friends. Clem began his career as a butcher at Weingarten's while participating in the Distributive Education class at Reagan High School. It was at Regan High School that he met the love of his life, Mary Elizabeth Nowak. They were married on April 19, 1952 in Houston, Texas. He later moved into sales and management for Blue Ribbon Meat Packing in Houston, Texas, retiring in 1983. Retirement did not sit well with Clem and he soon began looking for something to occupy his time. Thus began his tenure as head of custodial maintenance at Huntsville High School. Abiding by "Mr. Clem's" rules actually became part of the freshman orientation program and helped to instill "Hornet Pride". Clem retired from H.I.S.D. in 1996 and enjoyed several years of traveling with Mary before his illness. He especially enjoyed little side trips to Louisiana with friends and family and looked forward to family gatherings. Clem was a member of St. Joseph's Catholic Church in New

Waverly, having served on the parish council. He was also a member of the Lions Club and the Knights of Columbus, serving as Grand Knight. Visitation will be at Sam Houston Memorial Funeral Home in Huntsville, Texas from 5:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m., on Wednesday, March 26, 2008 with Rosary at 7:00 p.m. Services will be held at St Joseph's Catholic Church in New Waverly, Texas on Thursday March 27, 2008 at 10:00 a.m. Interment will follow at Shepard Hill Cemetery. A reception will follow at the Knights of Columbus Hall in Willis, Texas. Pallbearers will be grandsons, Kevin Slott, Clifford Slott, Clint Slott, Charlie Wilkerson, Justin Halter, grandson-in-law Richard Jackson and devoted friend Louis "Preacher" Falk.
