Corby McKenzie, born in Tampa, Florida, peacefully passed away at Memorial Hermann The Woodlands Hospital after a year-long battle with cancer, with his devoted wife Vicki McKenzie by his side on Sunday, March 3rd, 2024. He is survived by his loving wife Vicki McKenzie, his cherished children Christopher McKenzie, Hailey McKenzie, Coltin McKenzie, Madison Stankevitz, Taylor Decell, and son-in-law Kyle Decell, as well as his two adored grandchildren Hudson and Evelyn Decell.

Corby's passion for service ignited when he began volunteering with the Magnolia Fire Department in 2013. His dedication led him to be commissioned at Texas A&M Engineering Extension Service and he commenced his career with the South Montgomery County Fire Department in 2015. He also worked as a Security Officer at Memorial Hermann The Woodlands since 2007. Corby exemplified courage, selflessness, strength, and compassion in all aspects of his life. He saved lives and touched hearts every day.

His resilience, determination, and unwavering faith during his battle with cancer served as an inspiration to many.

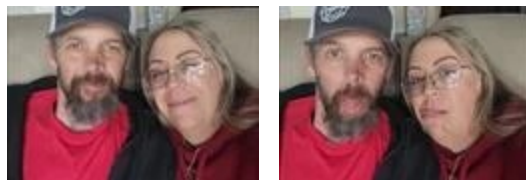

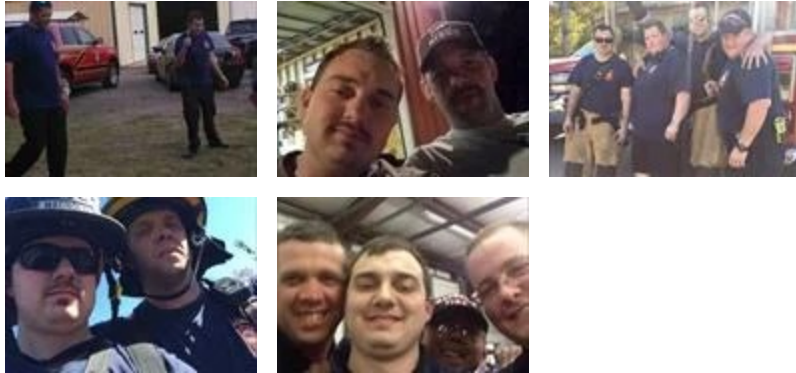
