Cynthia Ann Greene, of Montgomery, TX, went to be with the Lord on Thursday morning, July 31, 2025 at HCA Houston Healthcare Conroe. She was only 61 years old. The family is deeply saddened by her passing.

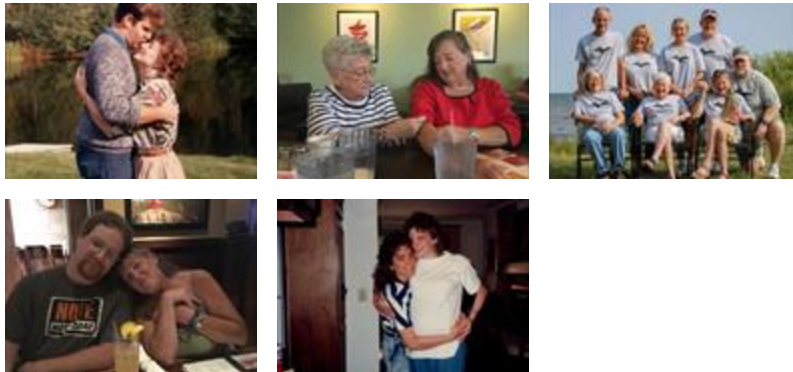
