



## Daniel Lee Wolfe

February 12, 1951 - October 5, 2017

Daniel Lee Wolfe, born Feb. 12, 1951, passed away Oct. 5 following a cardiac arrest at his home in Riverside, TX.

He is survived by his wife, Denise; daughters, Heather and Deonna; grandsons, Gabriel and Miles; sister, Lavern; and numerous extended family members and friends.

Daniel was born and raised in Fruitdale, Alabama. He left Alabama when he was 17 to join the US Army, where he served for 12 years. He specialized in linguistics and served in several locations around the world, including Vietnam, Alaska, Turkey, and Germany. While serving in Germany, he married his first wife, Teresa, and they had a daughter, Heather.

Dan returned to the Houston, Texas area around 1980, where he worked as a carpenter. Through his 35+ year career in construction, he worked up through ranks, eventually working as a project superintendent and manager. He was proud of what he built, and even prouder to earn the loyalty and respect of his coworkers and subcontractors through numerous projects. While in Texas, he met his current wife, Denise, and they married later that year on Wednesday, December 21st, 1983. They had their daughter, Deonna, in 1984.

His passion for motorcycles was unceasing; he started riding when he was 15 to travel between his sister's house in Chicago and his mother's house in Alabama. He collected numerous Moto Guzzis and other bikes through the years, but never wavered from the belief that the best thing to do with his collection was to use it. Although he was never able to make the long ride up

from Texas to Alaska, Daniel logged thousands of miles on his bikes... always looking forward to riding out to his weekend rallies on the roads less traveled. Daniel touched so many lives; he will be dearly missed.
