



## Danny Ray "Sug" Slott

January 4, 1951 - January 11, 2011

After a long, courageous battle with cancer, Danny Ray (SUG) Slott went to meet the Lord and his family. Born in Conroe, on January 4, 1951, his suffering was rewarded January 11, 2011, surrounded by his family at his home in New Waverly.

Survivors include his wife of 38 years, Pat Slott; devoted sons and their wives, Kevin and Nichole Slott of Spring, TX, Clifford and Heather Slott of New Waverly and Clint and Candace Slott of New Waverly. Not only did he spend his time hunting in New Waverly, but also made several trips to Colorado and West Texas. He also enjoyed fishing, especially the annual seining trips. Another enjoyment each year was to gather money for the Walker County Fair. With his efforts, numerous youth's projects were purchased through the New Waverly Group. It didn't matter whether they made the Big Sale, Horticulture,

Baked Goods, or Freezer Sale. His goal was to see they received a fair amount for their projects.
