David Phil Disman went home to be with his savior on Sunday June 8th, 2008, when the medical helicopter crashed while they were in route to Herman Hospital in Houston. He was born to Rosie Grimes-Head and Filmore Disman May 29th 1950 in San Angelo, Tx. He had two sisters and four brothers. At the age of eighteen he joined the Navy and was a Sub-tender during Vietnam. Before being deemed disabled he worked as a sewing machine repair man and a TDC Correctional Officer. He was preceded in death by his parents, and brother, Billy Joe. He is survived by his wife Audrey Disman, his two sons Johny Lynn Disman and wife Sherry Disman, Jason Lee Disman, and two step daughters Brianna Lee King, and Shannon Alliene Curry, sister Edith and brother-in-law, Jimmy Teague, sister Joyce McGee, Val, Frank, and Ray Lee Disman, all of Breckenridge. He is also survived by numerous grandchildren, neices, and nephews, and close family and friends.
