In the mid 80's David began selling cars. In 1988 he came to work in Huntsville at Goodman Dodge. He has remained in the car business where he has built and maintained several dealerships. David's proudest accomplishments were his family. David was a loving husband to Jackie Peters for 21 years. He was the devoted father of Dalyn Peters Hillman and the father and best friend to J.C. (Jack Clair) Peters. David was currently a managing partner of Team Dodge in Huntsville and Team Ford in Navasota. He was a member of the New Waverly ISD School Board and First Baptist Church of Huntsville. He was an avid fisherman and hunter. David was preceded in death by his father, Clair Richard Peters. He is survived by his wife, Jackie Peters; his mother, Ellen Peters; his brother, Steve Peters; daughter, Dalyn Peters Hillman; son, J.C.
