Donna Sue Oehme Blackmon, beloved wife, mom and Dedy, died August 30, 2016 at her home in Shenandoah, Texas. Donna was born in 1949 in Elk City, Oklahoma. Donna graduated from Westbury High School in Houston and attended Houston Baptist University. She later moved back to Oklahoma where she met and married her husband, Bill, of 46 years.

Donna and Bill moved to the Houston area in the early 70s to raise their family. Donna was passionate about her work for Kingwood Area EMS. She served as a volunteer EMT and office manager for a total of 34 years. She cherished the friends she made there and called them her KAEMSA Family.
