Doris Ann Hill died peacefully on August 27, 2024 at Methodist Retirement Center Creekside in Huntsville, Texas. She was born in Centralia, Illinois on April 16th, 1941 to Archie Lee Carder and Ellen Imelda (Jimmy) Carder. After attending Sunset High School in Dallas and UT Arlington she married Tom W. Hill in 1960. They soon moved to Austin and raised 2 children, Tom and Elizabeth.

In the early 1970's Doris was recognized by the local paper for becoming Austin's first female school crossing guard. She later worked for the Department of State Health Services as a data analyst. Following her interest in anthropology she joined the Travis County Archeology Society attending decades of events and summer field schools with the Texas Archeology Society. After retirement she also joined the Austin Butterfly Forum, local astronomy, and paleontology clubs. She further enjoyed volunteering at Pioneer Farms and at the Paramount Theater.

She is survived by her siblings Don Carder and Marian Treber. She is also survived by her son Tom, his wife Sue, and granddaughter Danielle Hill. She is survived by grandsons Joshua and Tim Lucas, Douglas and his wife Catherine Castleberry, and great granddaughter Taylor Castleberry. She was preceded in death by her parents Archie and Ellen, as well as her sister Margaret Dixon. She was further preceded in death by her son in law Joseph Lucas and daughter Elizabeth.
