Doris Marie Lowery was the only daughter born to Levi Donald and Mary Avangeline (Thomas) Young on May 27, 1924, in Grimes County, Texas. She passed into the loving and welcoming arms of her Savior and a host of family on Tuesday, September 1, 2015.

Doris will be remembered as a teacher first and foremost, teaching in Huntsville ISD and Aldine ISD during her teaching career as well as teaching Sunday school for children and adults. Her career was devoted primarily to the teaching of special needs students. She was voted Teacher of the Year while teaching in Aldine. Doris was a woman of extraordinary talents: an accomplished seamstress who could draft her own patterns, a baker who created beautiful, creatively decorated cakes; an author of poems published in the Huntsville Item and an essay which gained her first place in the Ladies Home Journal "Never Underestimate the Power of a Woman" contest and netted her her first computer. Her writing talent also extended to writing and directing the church Christmas play for many years when her family was young. Her passions were playing competitive dominoes, photographing Texas courthouses and spending time with family and friends.

Doris was preceded in death by her husband of 52 years, J.D. Lowery, daughter, Nancy Lowery Webster, her mother and father, and her brothers, Donald Anderson, J. C. "Jake", and David "Tubby" Young. A joyous family

reunion is taking place in Heaven today!
