Dorothy Lynn Cowart Roberson

Funeral services for Dorothy Lynn Cowart Roberson, 59, of Huntsville, are set for 11am Thursday Oct. 4 at Calvary Baptist Church on Highway 190 East in Huntsville. Burial will follow at Boswell Cemetery in Walker County. Visitation is scheduled for 5-7:30pm Wednesday, Oct. 3 at Sam Houston Memorial Funeral Home on Normal Park in Huntsville.

Dorothy, or "Buff" or "Miss Dorothy" as she was known to many who loved her, was born Feb. 19, 1953 in Huntsville. She passed on to glory Oct. 1, 2012 in Conroe.

Dorothy is survived by her husband, Kooter - her son, Jake - her mother, Birdy Jo Cowart Blalock - two sisters, Vicki Cowart Cooksey and Jo Ann Cowart Hooker. She was pre-deceased by her father, Doyle Cowart.

Dorothy was raised on Fish Hatchery Road, growing up in a Christian home in which the children were nurtured in the knowledge of God's own word. As a member of the National Honor Society, she graduated from Huntsville High School in 1971, and immediately began her lifelong career at Sam Houston State University. For more than 40 years she worked in the office of Academic Affairs, serving such outstanding educators as Rex Isham, Jack Humphries,

R.A. Reiner, Bobby Marks, James Gilmore, David Payne and Jamie Hebert, just to name a few. Along the way she made countless friends through her warm demeanor, her professional zeal, her loving ways and her winning smile. Dorothy really did love her job.

Along the way, Dorothy, although extremely involved in raising a family and working fulltime, was able to complete her bachelor's degree at SHSU in 2001 - one of her proudest accomplishments.

She was also an active member of "Belle Chanson" - Huntsville's select women's choir - and enjoyed every minute of the time she spent with her special friends who make up the membership of that ensemble.

Besides her family, Dorothy was most proud of The Children's Choir at Calvary Baptist Church - a program she founded so many years ago no one can quite remember the date. Through the years she led the program as she taught the value of being a Christian to hundreds of young minds who were always so eager to attend practice and performances with "Miss Dorothy."

Dorothy loved her lord, her family, her church and Sam Houston State University.

Her favorite saying was: "One hundred years from now, it won't matter what car I drove, what kind of house I lived in, how much I had in my bank account, nor what my clothes looked like. But, the world may be a little better because I was important in the life of a child."

Speakers at the funeral will include her brother-in-law Rev. Reagan Cooksey, the Pastor of Calvary Baptist Church Dr. James Featherstone, and her father-in-law Rev. A. Frank Roberson. Music will be performed by David Crain as well as members of Belle Chanson. Pallbearers will include Jamie Hebert,

Dick Eglsaer, Mitch Muesham, David Payne, Rodney Cooksey, Jack Roberson, Ray Black, Hub Randel, Jimmy Walker and David Harold Hooker.
