Dorothy J. Taylor Henderson slept peacefully away on January 8, 2020. She was born September 17, 1940 in San Jacinto County to Joe Milton and Lucrecia Taylor. She was the youngest of thirteen children. Dorothy graduated from Sam Houston High School in 1958.

Dorothy was baptized at an early age. Coming from a family of singers, Dorothy was an active member, choir president, and lead singer in the St. Paul UMC choir. She was a faithful member who served in many leadership positions at St. Paul UMC. Some would say her most important position was in the kitchen. Dorothy was known for her cornbread dressing and making sure the pastor had a plate or a pot.

Dorothy retired from the Walker County Jail System after 25 years of dedicated service. There she was affectionately called “Mama Dorothy” by coworkers and inmates. Her impact on those she touched lives was so great that many would reach out to her after release from jail just to let her know that they are doing better.

She was preceded in death by her parents, 5 sisters, 7 brothers, sons Ronald Taylor and Bobby Lathon, Sr.

She leaves to carry on her memory and legacy her husband, Herman Henderson of 47 years (married October 28, 1972), her devoted daughter, Debra Franklin and her two loving sons Milton Franklin, Sr. and Anthony Franklin. Her grandchildren (Wanza, Corey, Bobby Jr., Marcella, Milton Jr.,

and Herman), 7 great grandchildren, and a host of nieces and nephews will forever remember her with love. Her faithful brothers-in-law, Ronald Brantley and Leon Beverly and sisters-in-law Barbara Brantley and Cynthia Beverly will lovingly remember her.
